"Lastly, the 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon Signature is based all on Cabernet Sauvignon that spent 20 months in 65% new French oak. It's a classic wine that's packed with notions of blackcurrants, scorched earth, tobacco leaf and roasted herbs. Rich, full-bodied and concentrated, it has the most mid-palate depth of the trio, possessing building tannin, and a great finish. Another terrific wine from this estate, it has two to three decades of longevity ahead of it."
