"The 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon Signature is a blend of 92% Cabernet Sauvignon and 8% Petit Verdot. Deep purple-black in color, it charges forth with exuberant crème de cassis and minted chocolate notes on the nose with suggestions of baking spices, potpourri, dried lavender and salami. Medium to full-bodied, it fills the palate with vibrant black berries and minted flavors, framed by chewy tannins and finishing on an earthy note."

the Signature is defined by its textural richness and unctuousness. Plush, layered and deep, the 2016 has a lot to offer. Some of the wine's concentration has been achieved with a loss of aromatic definition and clarity, but the wine is nevertheless quite attractive. Cabernet Sauvignon Signature is primarily Cabernet Sauvignon yet includes 8% Petit Verdot, all aged 22 months in new French oak. This saturated purple-hued beauty boasts a deep, medium to full-bodied, concentrated vibe as well as terrific notes of spice black cherries, currants, graphite, cedarwood, and a kiss of chocolate. As with all these 2016 from this great estate, it has remarkable purity, ample mid-palate depth, and will benefit from short-term cellaring"
